Product Stewardship and Life Cycle Management play an important role at Elephants Foot Waste Compactors Pty Ltd (**EFoot**) as aim to minimise the health, safety, environmental and social impacts of our products throughout all the phases of their life-cycle.

In recognising our responsibilities as a corporate, social and environmentally responsible business, we have established measures to achieve our commitment to responsible product stewardship and life cycle management.

As a designer, manufacturer, supplier and industry leader, we understand that our responsibilities extend beyond the point of sale and any warranty periods. We further recognise our responsibility to the consumer, a key player within the environmental life cycle.

With a focus on our business operations, manufacturing partners and supply chain, we are committed to make a substantial contribution to a safer, cleaner and more sustainable environment for our planet and the community. To achieve our commitment, we aim to:

- Limit the amount of materials and resources required for manufacture;
- Streamline production process and partaking in activities such as full product refurbishment, disassembly for component reuse and recycle;
- Coordinate the donation of products to socially oriented and community based organisations;
- Minimising the generation of waste and reusing or recycling wherever possible;
- Reducing the amount of waste (including hazardous waste) for disposal; and
- Engaging with stakeholders regarding this policy and program
